Minor Puppy Dog: 1st Mcinnes's - Bullecourt Blessed Peace

Promising dark mask fawn, lovely rich pigmentation, very nice head for his age. Very settled and well behaved. Good topline and nice front, nice shapely body. Sound little mover.

2nd Orfanos's - Bousson Bon Voyage

Cobby brindle dog with a nice head, good amount of bone, nice rear. Really needs to mature and come together, was very distracted but still managed to move well.

3rd Atkinson's – Gefion Show Me the Money (IMP NZ)

Puppy Dog: 1st Shaw's – Ouioui eyes on Me

Smart brindle of good size and shape. Pleasing head with dark eyes, just the right amount of bone for his age, nice roach and well placed tail, movement was sound on all angles.

2nd Borg's – Llachar Xaviers inferno.

Dark brindle not as mature a 1, but still showing plenty of promise, good amount of bone and substance, with a nicely developing head, presented in lovely condition.

Junior Dog: 1st Ruddock and McCelland's - Llachar Unearth Valhalla

Attractive brindle dog with nice square head, framed with ears of ideal shape and size. Nicely wrinkled forehead.

Balanced overall shape with correct topline, straight front and moderately angled rear.

2nd Parry's - Ch. Tricibwthyn Gilbert.

Brindle dog that excelled in head properties with dark pigment and nice expression. Good cut up to loin and gentle roach. He still needs to mature a little more in body.

3rd Vassallo's – Ch. Boroccabull Tommy Hilfiger.

Intermediate Dog: 1st Macdonald, Mitchell and McAndrew's - Emorette Beau River

Very nicely balanced light brindle dog that really caught my eye, very attractive head, nicely padded cheeks and fill under eyes, lovely muzzle and turn up of underjaw. Super ears of ideal shape and size, carried well, everything in proportion. In excellent overall condition with sufficient muscle and bone. Moved soundly from all angles.

## Challenge Dog and Reserve Best in Show.

2nd Doldissen's – Ch. Myreluchi Monsieur Marty.

Lovely cobby brindle dog, plenty of bone, good sturdy front. Nice overall shape, attractive masculine head with dark eyes and pigment. Good depth and shape of chest, nice topline and rear, movement was sound.

3rd Shaw's - Ch. Shaunuff Mason

Australian Bred Dog: 1st McAndrew's – Emorette Blaise Pascal

Masculine brindle with a very well put together head, square with good muzzle. Ideal size ears of ideal shape carried well . Good reach of neck. Very nice outline, good strong front. Moved very well.

2nd Miniter and O'Connor's – Ch. Briallen Elvisrunsriot

Compact brindle with a nice neck and pleasing head. Nice chest, good depth and ideal length. Very nice rear angulation, I would have liked a little more cut up to loin to finish the overall picture.

3rd Casey, Sealy and Cadd's – Ch. Kiangsi Jett Stream.

**Open Dog**: 1st Ledger and Paine's – Jonhah Im just a Hobo

Nicely marked brindle with sweet expression, excellent ear carriage and ideal shape. Good pigmentation and lovely dark eyes, good overall head, nice shape of muzzle. Compact body with just the right amount of bone, nice straight front and good rear angulation, very sound dog. **Reserve Challenge Dog** 

2nd Duncan's - Sancerre Didier.

Nice dark masked fawn, good pigmentation and dark eyes of good shape, set well in the skull, would like a little more depth in the muzzle. Broad shoulders, nice front, plenty of bone and substance overall. Good rear end, moved soundly. 3rd Frazer, Hedberg and O'Rourke's – Pendragan Coeur De Lion.

Minor Puppy Bitch: 1st Casey's – Asharnay Moon Dancer.

Very promising fawn bitch, with a nice overall shape with good bone, stocky with substance. Very pleasing head with lovely dark eyes and mask. Ideal muzzle shape, padded with good underjaw. Moved really well for her age, all angles. 2nd Giorgioni's – Tuiwood C'est Si Bon (IMP NZ)

Smart brindle bitch with nice lines, just the right amount of bone for her age. Strong straight front, good topline, well placed tail. Feminine expression, her head is maturing well, but needs to catch up a little on 1st place. Movement was good.

3rd McCelland's - Llachar Xanthias Rose.

Puppy Bitch: 1st McInnes's - Bullecourt Beer Sheba

Fawn bitch 8 months of age. Very promising puppy, with most attractive head and expression, lovely dark eyes and head framed with well carried ears of just the right shape and size. Nice overall body shape with good front, shoulders and neck. Ideal topline and tailset, good rear angulation just needs to mature. Very sound mover. **Best Puppy in Show** 2nd Tatian and O'Rourke's – Pendragan Georgy Girl.

Slightly longer cast in appearance than 1st, but could come together as she matures. Very shapely front and rear, with good angualtion, nice reach of neck. Well placed tailset. Nice brindle coat of good texture. Moved well.

3rd Gettans's - Hushan Ce-Bon

Junior Bitch: 1st Arunachalam's - Senarabull Serphina

Compact brindle bitch, in good coat. Good width of front, straight with ideal amount of bone and nice feet.

Very pleasing head, with dark eyes, giving a nice feminine expression. Strong arched neck, flowing in strong shoulders and deep chest. Nice rear end, gentle roach and finished with well placed tail. **Reserve Challenge Bitch** 

2nd McAndrew's - Emorette Miss Remi

Another quality brindle, with nice expression, lovely dark pigmention, solid on her feet, nice wide front and deep chest, good rear angulation. At this stage I just preferred the overall shape of 1st.

3rd Swiitt's - Swifdelight Miss Monroe.

Intermediate Bitch: 1st McAndrew's - Emorette Miss Leuca

Very nice shaped brindle bitch. Nice topline and cut up to loin. Very good shoulders, strong front and feet. Pretty head and good neck. Very nice chest of ideal shape and depth.

2nd Scott and McCelland's - Llachar Titanium Heart

Very nice brindle bitch, compact with nice overall balance and substance, nice covering of muscle. Very attractive head, with pleasing expression, good ears carried well. Nice roach and sound movement. Very close decision between first and second place.

3rd Ledger and Paine's – Jonhah Howd you get so Fly.

Australian Bred: 1st McWatt's - Ch Emorette Eadee Ma Mere (AI)

Brindle girl with a very nice head and soft expression, well padded muzzle, gentle wrinkle of forehead. Ears of good size and shape, carried well. Good body shape, with sufficient amount of bone and substance, gentle roach. Ideal angulation front and rear. Good movement.

2nd Cassidy's - Ch Maplewood Hello

Another attractive brindle girl with nice head and body shape. Good shape of neck and topline, with nice cut up.

Straight front, strong pasterns and good rear end. moved soundly.

3rd Wedesweiler's - Frogwyck Petite Fleur

**Open Bitch:** 1st Arunachalam's – Ch Senarbull Miss Claire

Beautiful, typy brindle bitch, really caught my eye with her quality. Compact shapely body without excess. Very balanced head, nice muzzle, mouth and underjaw, well padded cheeks and subtle wrinkle of forehead. Strong well angled shoulders and straight front, with nice feet. Nice gentle roach and cut up to well developed loin. Moved very well with confidence from all angles. Very pleasing to award her **Challenge Bitch and Best of Breed** 

2nd McWatt's - Ch Abiaan Primadonna Girl (AI)

Nice compact brindle of good overall shape and size. Very balanced, with ideal muscle tone, very solid on her feet, well developed shoulders and nice topline, good chest shape. Feminine head, square with soft expression, lovely dark eyes and pigmentation. Moved soundly
