Introducing our Judge – Ann Wilman (UK)

Along with my parents, we run the Wildax Kennels. My paternal grandparents showed Smooth and Wire Haired Fox Terriers in the 1920s and 30s and later showed Boxers in the UK in 1947. The Wildman family was heavily involved with dogs long before I was born so I have been brought up with dogs and dog showing to me is just a natural part of my life and I would not want it any other way.

I started working in obedience, doing working trials & tracking with my father when I was a young girl, progressing into the show ring later with Boxers. I have also been successful in the show ring with Bulldogs, Boston Terriers and of course French Bulldogs.



I was awarded Best of Breed at Crufts in 2014 with my French Bulldog Ch Wildax Miss Money Penny she was also Top French Bulldog in the UK in 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012. We have won the Top Breeder, Top Dog, Top Puppy, Top Sire, Top Dam, Top Stud award many times in Boston Terriers, and Top Breeder in French Bulldogs. My parents hold the record for breeding the most UK Champions in Boston Terriers.

We have also been awarded Best of Breed at Crufts with a Bulldog Wildax Paris and the Reserve CC with Ch Wildax Fancy Nancy and Best of Breed quite a few times with Boston Terriers. I have bred Champions in Boxers, Bulldogs, Boston Terriers and French Bulldogs.

I am the secretary of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club and thoroughly enjoy the administration side of dog showing. I have actually been on quite a few committees and was a committee member of the Liverpool Kennel Association when I was a teenager.

I am considered to be a bull breed specialist and I write the breed notes for the French Bulldogs in the weekly UK canine publication Our Dogs. I also get asked to write articles all over the world on the various breeds I have lived with. I have written articles for the Frenchie Focus book in the USA and also for The World of Frenchies book. I started judging in 1984 and judge all breeds and Best in Show at Open Show level. I awarded CCs in Boxers, Bulldogs, Boston Terriers, Akita's and French Bulldogs.

I have also lectured on Bulldogs and French Bulldogs not only in the UK but also in Japan. I have arranged seminars so that up-and-coming Judges can learn about the breed.

When I have judged in Sweden and Australia I have had students in the show ring with me, so that they can learn the finer points of the breed.

I have judged in many different countries including Russia, Portugal, Estonia, Slovakia, Italy, Germany, Belgium, France, Netherlands, Norway, Hungary, Lithuania, Spain, Holland, Finland, Denmark, Latvia, Australia, USA and Japan.

Introducing our Monday Judge – Sonia Davis (UK)

I showed dogs as a teenager starting off with Boxers which I had some success in the showing with. When I was 21 years of age I purchased my first Bulldog. I have bred many Bulldog Champions including Ch Rowendale Rum Truffle who won 4 Best in Shows at General Championship shows and was the record-winning Bulldog for 16 years.

Along with my wife we now show and breed French Bulldogs and Boston Terriers, we have bred quite a few Champions and currently have 8 UK Champions sitting on the settee at home.



I award CCs in French Bulldogs and Bulldogs and have judged all over the world including the USA, Australia, Japan and extensively throughout Europe and I was honoured to judge Bulldogs at Crufts in 2022. I have recently been passed to award CCs in Boston Terriers for January 2024.

I am an active committee member of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club and a member of the Royal Kennel Club.
